- Bookshop, on the 2nd floor.
- Shops close 15 minutes prior to the Museum's closing time.

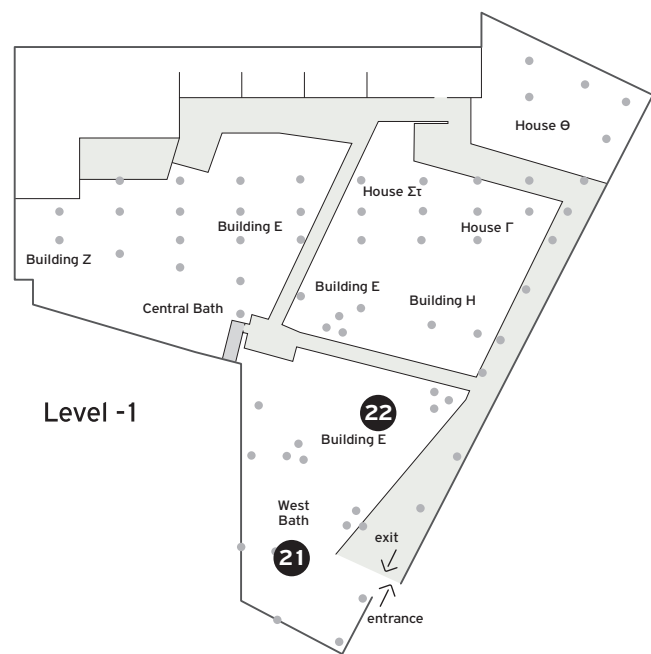

map of the acropolis museum



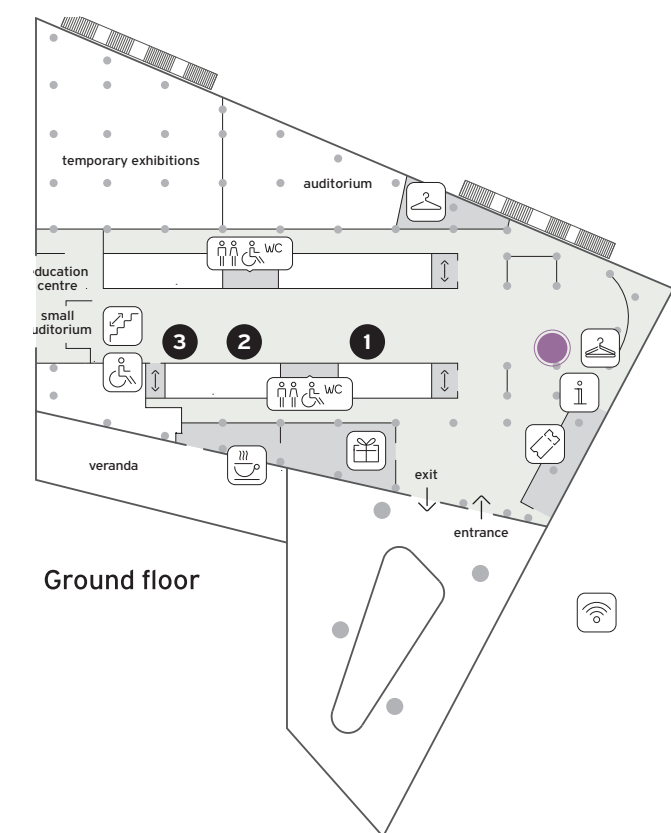

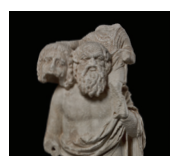

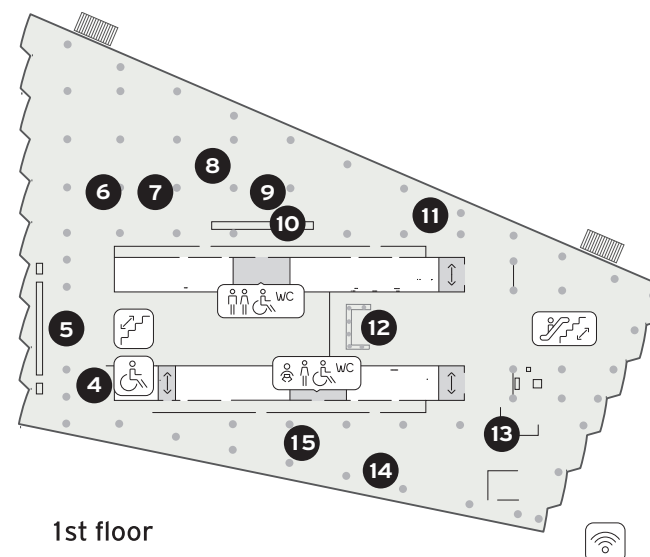

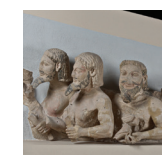

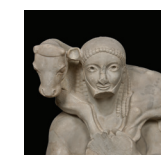


4. Bronze disk with Gorgon

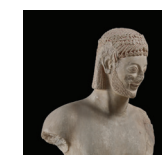

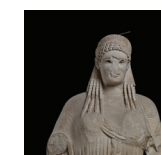

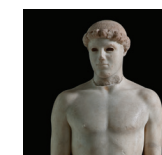

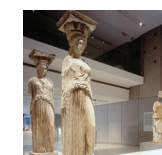

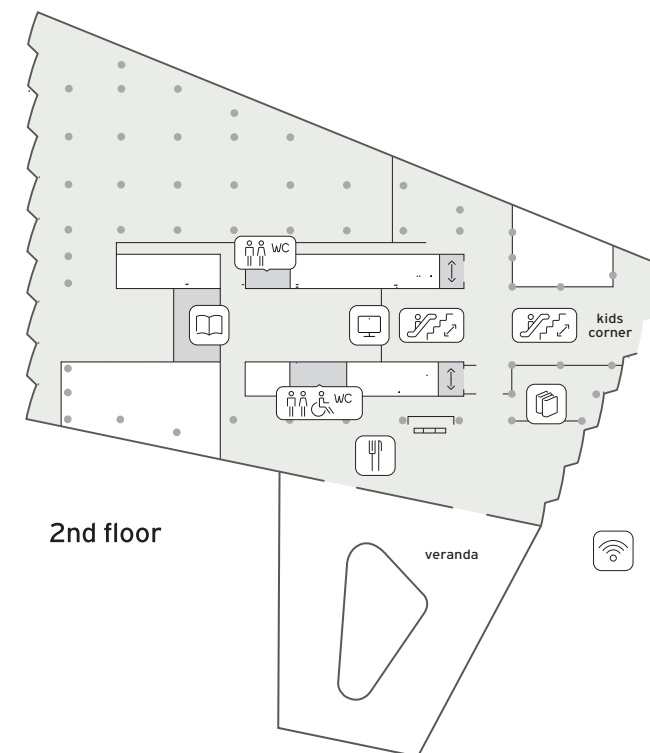

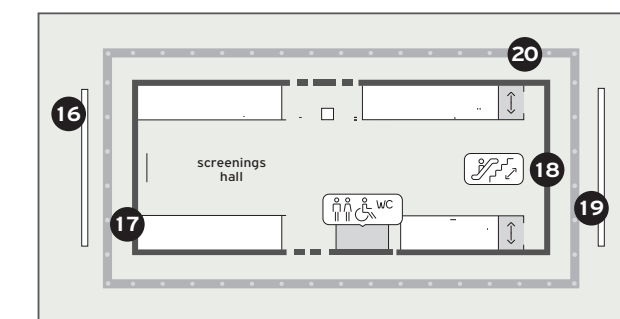
