


On this small pediment we can see Zeus and Hera receiving Herakles on Mount Olympus. See how clearly you can still see the color that originally was painted on the pediment



6. Athena

This statue of Athena once decorated the pediment that showed the Gigantomachy, that is, the battle between the Olympian Gods and the Giants. The Goddess wears the aegis, an overcoat, with frightening snakes around its edges. The Goddess' opponent was the Giant Engelados of which only part of a foot survives!





7. Demeter

The marble relief you see here shows two goddesses arm in arm. On the left is Demeter and on the right her daughter, Persephone.

8. Ares

On the marble relief the God Ares wears his armour and leans on his shield. He is crowning a man.




